

§ 1 Principles

(1) On the occasion of the corona pandemic, everyone should reduce the physical-social contacts with other people to the essential minimum, except with relatives of their own household, their partner as well as the person(s) for whom a custody or access right exists, or with relatives of another Household or with up to ten other people. Wherever it is possible, a minimum distance of 1.5 meters to other people has to be kept and further actions to prevent contagion should be considered (contact restriction). These principles apply to all areas of life, including workplaces.

(2) To reduce the risk of an infection for yourself and others, it is highly recommended to wear an oral and nasal cover when there's any contact to other people in public, especially with people at particular risk. This also includes regular hand hygiene and the avoidance of hand-face contact. Parents and legal guardians should ensure that their children or guardians comply with these recommendations if they are able to do so. People with disabilities and those with health restrictions can avoid wearing the mouth and nose cover if they are not able to use it. It is allowed to temporarily take off the mouth and nose cover if you are communicating with aurally handicapped people who rely on reading lip movements.

§ 2 Contact restrictions, distance regulations, mouth-nose cover

(1) Private get-togethers at home are permitted without limitation to the number of people.

(2) Meetings and gatherings in public spaces are only permitted alone and with the relatives of your own household, accompanied by your partner, with persons for whom there is a custody or access right, and

1. with relatives of another household or
2. with up to ten other people.

(3) Family celebrations (including weddings, birthdays, funeral ceremonies, anniversary celebrations, family school start or graduation celebrations) in restaurants or separate rooms provided by third parties are acceptable with up to 100 people from the family, friends and acquaintances. The hygiene regulations should be kept.

(4) The minimum distance of 1.5 meters does not apply in day care centers, in schools and at school events. Alternative protection measures can be determined by the general decree of the State Ministry of Social Affairs and Social Cohesion to regulate the operation of day care facilities and schools in connection with the fight against the corona pandemic.

(5) A mouth and nose cover must be worn

1. when using public transport, coaches and regular driving services for the purpose of transporting people with disabilities or people in need of care between their place of residence / residence and facilities and

2. when staying in shops and stores. Sentence 1 does not apply to the personnel, as far as other protective measures have been taken or there is no customer contact.

§ 1 paragraph 2 sentences 3 to 5 apply accordingly. Insofar the usage and stay according to sentence 1 cannot be denied for reasons of infection protection law.

(6) Deviating from paragraph 2, outdoor sports are permitted in compliance with the hygiene rules according to § 4.

(7) Meetings and gatherings in public spaces are allowed in deviation from paragraph 2 if the minimum distance of 1.5 meters is kept. § 5 remains unaffected.

(8) Beyond the meetings and gatherings mentioned in paragraphs 2, 3, 6 and 7, meetings and gatherings in public spaces are forbidden.
